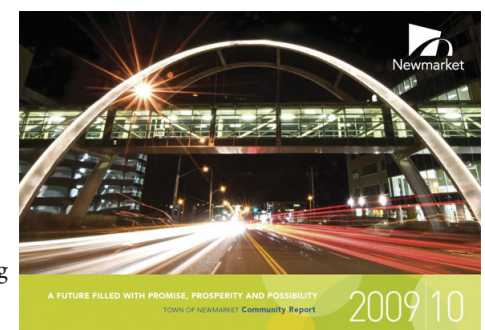

- If your name is missing or if you are listed incorrectly, obtain a revision form from the Town Clerk's Office. Forms are available from **September 7 to October 25, 2010** during regular office hours (8:30 to 4:30 p.m.)

If your name is not on the voters' list and you do not show acceptable identification at the voting location, you will be unable to vote.
