))) **Reminder: Winter Parking Restrictions are in Effect**

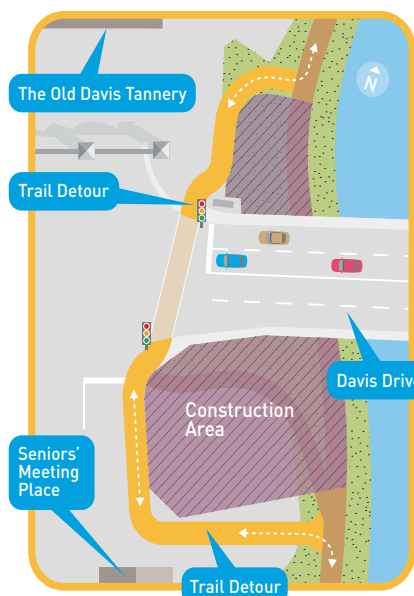
Residents are reminded that as of **November 1**, it is strictly prohibited to park a vehicle on any roadway:

As part of the construction program for the vivaNext rapidways along Davis Drive, reconstruction of the south side of the Keith Bridge will take place from November 2010 until December 2011.
