))) Internet Safety Workshop

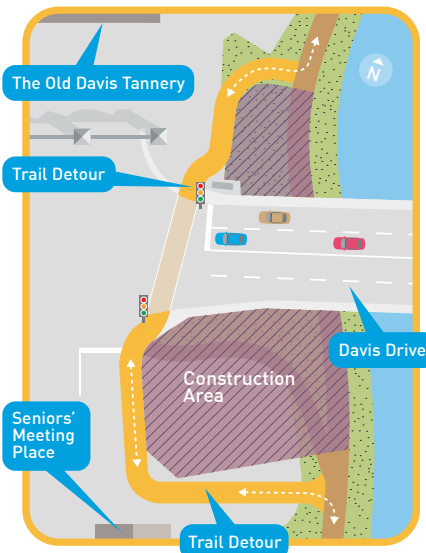
