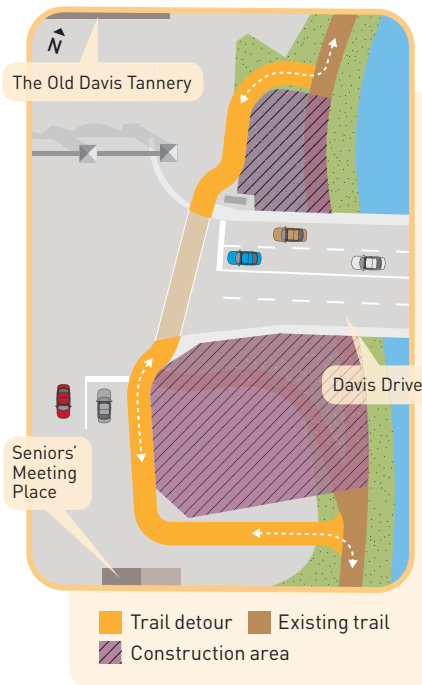
### ))) Drawing and Painting Classes with Cathy Gifford
